




- Overall Impact: Give2Asia has delivered US\$535 million in grants to over 2.100 local charities across 30+ countries



FIG 03 KEY FACTORS INFLUENCING DONORS' GIVING


FIG 04 TOP GIVING CAUSES AMONG DONOR PARTICIPANTS











Readiness Level for Cross-Border Giving - HIGH








Diaspora donors, younger donors, and corporations with a regional footprint






Readiness Level for Cross-Border Giving - MEDIUM






China and Singapore both face highly restrictive regulations toward cross-border giving.


